


FIND YOUR RING SIZE

To find your ring size, first take a well-fitting ring that you already own and measure the inside diameter with a ruler, then compare it with the table and template below. Print this page in landscape on A4 paper. If you don't make any adjustments in your printing settings, the page should print in its original size. Place your ring on the circle templates to compare the sizes - the red circle should be visible inside the ring. The measurements are not 100% accurate, but it's a good start.

Note: For rings that are narrower or more rounded you should take a ring size that is at least one size smaller and for wider rings take one size up. Just make sure to measure the ring size on the hand on which you want to wear the ring, because the same finger might be a slightly different size on your other hand.
